How does the school know if my child needs extra help and what should I do if I think my child may have SEN?

- Initially contact form tutor to discuss any concerns
- School assesses student's needs using
 - Assessment Data
 - Transition information
 - Teacher observations
 - Parental Input

How will the school staff support my child?

- Form tutor and pastoral team support
- Differentiated teaching in lessons
- Intervention work, according to individual needs

How will I know how my child is doing?

- Tracking and reporting data 3 times a year
- Parents' meetings and consultations
- Contact with Learning Support dept.
- Annual Review for students with an EHC Plan

How will the learning and development provision be matched to my child's needs?

- Careful planning and differentiation by subject teachers and leaders
- Pastoral mentoring
- Monitoring of progress

What support will there be for my child's overall well-being?

- Form tutor and pastoral team
- PSHEE Programmes
- Positive relationships with parents, school and children
- Mentoring (adult or peer)
- Wider outcomes : extracurricular activities, chaplaincy etc.

What training have the staff supporting children with SEND had or are having?

- As all teachers are teachers of SEND, they will have appropriate and regular training

- See Herts Local Offer for services available to all secondary schools

How will you help me to support my child in their learning? How will I be involved in the discussion?

- Parent Consultation
- Contact with pastoral team
- Moodle and SMHW

- Appropriate provision and reasonable adjustments will be made where necessary
- Medical support in place where necessary
