There are 4 sectors of Journalism, Broadcast Journalism, Magazine Journalism, Newspaper Journalism, and Web Journalists. Journalists research, write, edit, proofread and file news stories, features and articles. Their pieces are used on television and radio or within magazines, journals and newspapers, in print and online.

Average Salary: £25,607
