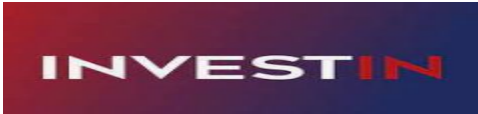
Visit this website to find impartial videos to support students who are considering going to university in the future, to help them make informed subject decisions.
