School Uniform from April 2019

Full uniform is compulsory and must be worn at all times. All items of clothing must be marked clearly with pupil's name. Fosters Schoolwear and Uniform4Kids (U4K) are our uniform stockists.

Parents are asked to contact the school before buying any item of uniform that they are uncertain about.

Items of uniform marked with an X on the table below are only available from the school uniform suppliers. All other items can be purchased from the school supplier, chain stores or sports shops.

- No jewellery may be worn apart from a plain cross and chain, wrist watch and one pair of plain gold or silver stud earrings in the earlobe.
- Please note that no jewellery of any value is to be worn.
- "Smart" watches are not permitted due to safeguarding issues.
- For safety reasons, long hair should be tied back, not up for the reason of safety.
- Extreme hairstyles e.g. tinted or dyed hair are not acceptable.
- Any and every extreme haircut as judged by the Headteacher specifically those with shaven sections contrasting other sections of longer, scissor cut hair are not permitted.
- All hair accessories must be navy blue or black.
- Make-up, fake tan and nail varnish and other noticeable appearance altering treatments e.g. eyebrow treatments, fake lashes must not be worn.
- The use of nail extensions are not permitted due to health and safety concerns.
