

Guide to completing an application for Free School Meals

You will need to apply for a Free School Meal via the [Hertfordshire County Council website](#).

Y3+ children

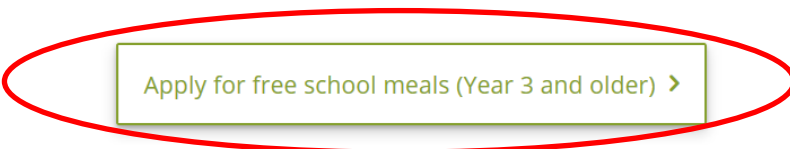
Once you're on the [Free School Meals page](#) click on the 'Apply for free school meals (Year 3 and older)' button:

Children in Year 3 or older

Your child could get a free school meal if you receive any of the following:

- **Income Support**
- **Income-based Jobseekers Allowance**
- **Income-related Employment and Support Allowance**
- **Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
- **The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit**
- **Child Tax Credit** (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you don't get more than **£16,190** a year)
- **Working Tax Credit run-on** (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- **Universal Credit** (with annual earned income of no more than **£7,400** after tax and not including any benefits you get).

Apply today if you receive any of these benefits. It takes **5 mins** and in most cases we can tell you straightaway if your child can get free meals at school.

For use on train journeys to and from school/college within Hertfordshire. Must be in full-time post-compulsory education and resident in Hertfordshire. Allows train travel at two thirds of adult season ticket fare.	☐
