How to get your award:

12 categories in total (see next slide for examples)

Academic progress, Attendance, Common good/Charity, School community, Competition, Extra-curricular, Leadership, Literacy, Personal development, Physical fitness, Spiritual life, Super-curricular



To achieve a **bronze award** you must have completed something in **4** of the above categories (Nov after AP1)

To achieve a **bronze award/silver award** you must have completed something in **8** of the above categories (Jan after AP2)

To achieve a **bronze award/silver award/gold award** you must have completed something in all **12** categories (April after AP3)

St Mary's Focus	Examples
Academic progress	A2L >1 or improved by 0.25%
Attendance	95% + or attendance improved by 3%+ since last AP
Common good/charity	Random Acts of Kindness (RAK), Red Wednesday, Cardinal Hume, reading buddies, peer mentoring
School community	Open evening, peer mentoring, student librarian, careers, school shows/concerts (drama and music)
Competition	Royal Science society Book competition, Olympiad Science competitions, Maths challenge, Poetry competition, Geography
Extra-curricular	Lunch time and after school clubs, Attendance at GCSE/A level booster sessions, peer mentoring
Leadership	Peer mentoring, Anti-bully rep, student council and any other form roles, Coaching
Literacy	Library activity, Book review, accelerated reader, lexia progress for student engaged in this, reading books, specialist magazines and journals
Personal development	Attendance at GCSE/A level sessions, Careers carousel, enrichment activities, coaching, peer mentoring, reading books, specialist magazines and journals, academic competitions, trips, work experience, Music , Drama, DOE
Physical fitness	IH , sports, after school extra-curricular PE ,DOE
Spiritual life	Liturgy, Charity events, assembly, class prayer, retreat
Super-curricular	Online webinars, reading books, specialist magazines and journals, visiting museums and galleries, watching films and documentaries, listening to podcasts, attending online seminars and lectures, entering academic competition
