- 5. Close the gaps




Identify the key knowledge that needs to be learned Make sure that you have access to the information that you need to learn.







Retrieval practice - Strategies

- 1.Flash cards (<u>www.quizlet.com</u>, <u>www.ankiapp.com</u>, <u>www.brainscape.com</u>)
- 2. Quick recall questions
- 2. Multiple choice quizzes
- 3.Brain dumps
- 4.Exam style questions (past papers)







How can you support your child with practice?

- 1. Check that they have access to the key knowledge that they need to learn.
- 2. Support them with their systems organisation of folders.
- 3. Remind them about the importance of using effective learning strategies.
- 4. Support them with their retrieval practice quizzing and to identify and close gaps.
- 5. Support them to plan their time and space out their practice.
- 6. Help them with setting up the right environment for study.



SUPERVISED STUDY

- Timetabled sessions
- Success in these is dependent on preparation
- Students that pre-plan these activities will remain in control
- Opportunity for collaboration and peer working to maximise learning


